PARENTS' CODE OF ETHICS

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for ALL players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will remember that the game is for the youth – not the adults. Keep comments positive on and off the field.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. Criticizing officials, coaches or opponents, using abusive language or cursing will not be tolerated.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation when needed for my child.
- I will do what I can to help all youth sports organizations to implement good sportsmanship.
- I will respect my child's coach by only assisting him when asked to do so.

Policy Enforcement:

1. Individuals will be given one warning for inappropriate activities.
2. Individuals that continue will be asked to leave the field.
3. Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the President of the BJSJA Director, including permanent ban from practices and or games.
